## ANNUAL REPORT OF THE ASSOCIATED MINISTRIES OF MOUNDRIDGE - July 31, 2021

The Associated Ministries of Moundridge (AMM) recently completed another fiscal year. After a year where a couple of our ministries closed down because of the Corona Virus, all of our ministries are back in operation. Angel's Attic was only open for 6 ½ months the last year but they are again accepting inkind donations. They are open two days a week for 2 hour segments. Linda Graber is working with day to day operations. Delonna Barnett is still involved with the bookkeeping. After cancelling Vacation Bible School last year, the VBS coordinators organized a three-day event for this year. The average attendance was 58 students per night and about 30 volunteers helped make it happen. Lory Fisher was acting director this year.

Since the pandemic began, Cradle to Crayons has had to close their doors twice because of student and staff corona virus cases. After being closed for 10 days, Cradle to Crayons has been able to open and continue operations. A record number of students were served this year. An additional toddler room is being added this year and increasing numbers are expected again this coming year.

The Senior Center has been serving meals the entire year. While the total number of meals served last year did not change significantly from the previous year, a higher percentage of the meals were delivered to homes and fewer were eaten inhouse. The Senior Center is also the distribution point for government commodities. Requests for commodities have been increasing the past year.

The Food Pantry underwent another change in leadership this past year. Kathy Fenksy is currently acting director. After not having regular open hours during the pandemic, the Food Pantry is again open regular hours three days a week.

The Blood Mobile was able to continue holding their events every other month as originally scheduled. All drives this year were held at West Zion Mennonite Church. Because of pandemic limitations, no canteen was provided. The Red Cross did provide snacks and water for all donors. The three Bloodmobile coordinators are Denise Stucky, Jerry Schrag and Carol Zerger.

The Youth Ministries completed a relatively normal year. They averaged serving about 80 5<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> graders. At this time they are planning to start up again in September.

Helping Hands continues to make money available to community members facing unexpected financial crises and to transients passing through with immediate food, gas or lodging needs. We helped out to the tune of just under \$4,600. We assisted with utilities, rent and house payments, gas, lodging and transportation.

Associated Churches of Moundridge would like to thank the churches and the Moundridge community for its generous support. Our ministries rely heavily on donations of money and time. The consolidated net income for the year was positive. That is always a good sign and with the additional challenges presented by the pandemic, we had a very good year! We solicit your continued support as we provide Christ-centered services for all segments of our community.
